

Urgent steps needed

- Global rate of species extinction right now is at least tens to hundreds of times higher than it has averaged over the past 10 million years
- UK has lost more biodiversity than any G7 country, and is in worst global 10%
- ▶ Growing awareness of harm from two major air pollutants: NO₂ and fine particulates
- 2022 the warmest year since 1659





No. 1 cause - loss of habitat

- From 1998 to 2008, in London alone, an area of vegetated garden land the size of 2.5 Hyde Parks was lost each year.
- ► Area of garden buildings up 55%
- Overall vegetation decreased 16%.

- 2021 Environment Bill 10% net gain
- Government pledge to reduce carbon emissions by 78% by 2035
- Camden Clean Air Action Strategy revisions
